Global Opportunities

Our school maintains ties to more than 200 business schools worldwide. From the very beginning, providing global opportunities for students has been at the heart of our international work. Throughout every academic year, more than 600 Mannheim students go on exchange and in reverse, our partner schools send the same number of visiting exchange students to us. We also offer double degrees as well as special certificate programs, and we participate in case competitions and take students on study trips abroad.

We offer the full range of business studies from bachelor's to doctoral programs. Our flagship undergraduate program is a Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA). Our consecutive master's program is the Mannheim Master in Management (MMM). Except from the core courses, MMM students choose their curriculum according to their personal interests. MMM students enjoy the freedom of studying in the most flexible master's program in business administration in Germany while benefitting from one of the most comprehensive curricula in an FT-ranked graduate business program.
