STUDY PLAN

In general, double degree students take all course work required to obtain both degrees without extending the standard study period of four semesters. Therefore, please make sure to plan your course of studies thoroughly as early as possible (according to the plan below).

You will spend the first part of your studies in Mannheim, where you will take the five MMM core courses (see table) in addition to electives from the area of information systems.

During your time at CBS in the third and fourth semester, you will take four courses to fulfill the degree requirements and then write your master thesis.
