

## DOUBLE DEGREE - INFORMATION FOR ESSEC STUDENTS

You will study in our **Mannheim Master in Management** program. Our Business School is one of the most renowned in Europe, known as the breeding ground for future managers. Six areas of study cover a broad spectrum of research and teaching fields in business administration.

This program puts a focus on professional work experience. In addition to the academic work, **professional experience of 12 months** is required for graduation. Prior professional experience may count towards this requirement; the approval is administered by ESSEC.

### STUDY PLAN

In general, double degree students take all course work required to obtain both degrees without extending the standard study period of four semesters. Therefore, please make sure to plan your course of studies thoroughly as early as possible (according to the plan below).

You will spend the first part of your studies at ESSEC Business School, where you will earn 60 ECTS – usually by taking the nine core courses of the ESSEC M.Sc. and at least three electives. The second part of your studies will be spent at the University of Mannheim. During this time you will take the four core courses of the MMM as well as electives worth at least 8 ECTS and a research seminar (7xx module). Please note, that you need to fulfill the requirements for writing a master thesis with these courses. Details can be found in the MMM module catalog.

1) It is required to attend 5 cross-disciplinary courses (SPOC): Responsible Leadership, Climate Change, Diversity and Inclusion, Entrepreneurship, Artificial Intelligence. These courses cannot be transferred to the MMM.

2) If an equivalent course was taken at ESSEC, the respective MMM core course can be waived and substituted by an elective course of the MMM. A list of equivalent courses is available on our online platform ILIAS.

3) Can be chosen freely from the course portfolio of the MMM.

4) The thesis prerequisites must be covered with elective business courses together with the research seminar.
