STUDY PLAN

In general, double degree students take all course work required to obtain both degrees without extending the standard study period of four semesters. Therefore, please make sure to plan your course of studies thoroughly as early as possible (according to the plan below).

You will spend the first and second semester in Mannheim, where you will take the five core courses of the MMM, as well as electives of at least 32 ECTS. Two of these courses must be courses that are equivalent to the major you wish to pursue at NHH.

The second half of your studies will be spent at NHH in Bergen. During this year, you will earn 30 ECTS as part of a 'major' at NHH and write your master thesis on a topic related to your major.

1) Can be chosen freely from the course portfolio of the MMM. At least two of them must be equivalent to courses within the major chosen at NHH, if not already covered by MMM core courses. A list of equivalencies is available from the program manager.

2) Courses without a grade cannot be transferred to Mannheim. Such coursework can only be done on top of the double degree requirements.

MASTER THESIS

The master thesis is executed at and supervised by the NHH.
