

# Admission Requirement English Proficiency

For both the German-English and English tracks, you must demonstrate a high level of English proficiency, equivalent to C1 level. This can be verified through one of the following:

1. Completion of a prior course of study in which at least 40 percent of the coursework (based on ECTS credits) was conducted in English, including both instruction and examinations. To confirm this, you may submit a signed and stamped form from your university certifying that at least 40 percent of your credits were earned in English-taught courses. The form provided by our university ([available here](#)) must be completed, signed, and stamped by your previous university. Once completed, it can be submitted as proof of English proficiency as part of your application.

Please Note: Graduates of the **B.Sc. Business Administration program at the University of Mannheim** are exempt from submitting this form, as the percentage of coursework completed in English is clearly indicated on the transcript. For these applicants, the Bachelor's certificate or transcript alone is sufficient proof of English proficiency.

2. a university entrance qualification from an English-speaking school system.
3. Test of English as a Foreign Language - Internet Based Test (TOEFL iBT) with a minimum score of 100.
4. the European Language Certificate (telc) - English University with at least (language) level C1.
5. certificate in Advanced English (CAE).
6. certificate of proficiency in English (CPE).
7. International English Language Testing System Academic Test (IELTS) with at least band 7.0.
8. [Language certificate of the University of Mannheim Service und Marketing GmbH](#) with at least (language) level C1 in the areas of Listening Comprehension, Written Language, Spoken Language and Reading Comprehension. This is also available to external applicants.

## Important notes:

- ⇒ **Only** the certificates listed here will be accepted. Other certificates, tests or confirmations cannot be considered.
- ⇒ The English certificate is an **admission requirement**. If you cannot submit it within the application deadline, you may submit it until 15 August. A submission after 15 August is excluded.
- ⇒ If you submit a test result/certificate as proof of language proficiency, it must **not be older than two years** on the application deadline date (15 May) in order to be recognized.
- ⇒ **TOEFL**: All three variants of the TOEFL test are accepted as equivalent (traditional TOEFL iBT, TOEFL iBT Home Edition). To have the result sent directly to the Admissions Office of the University of Mannheim, the institution code "0254" applies. We only accept the Test Date Scores. The Mybest scores will not be considered.
- ⇒ **IELTS**: Only the overall band score counts towards the minimum requirement.
