What should/could be improved?

Case discussing is too long (difficult to concentrate
in 2nd half)

- Even though the cases are supposed to encourage critical and creative thinking, the questions could have been a little more straightforward.
- sometimes not all questions were discussed with no real opportunity to learn from mistakes as there was neither ^{the} 'correct' nor one possible 'correct' solution provided.

Maybe less case studies but in exchange better feedback. No learning effect from case studies if feedback is not sufficient.

Smaller discussion groups

Ability to switch sessions if necessary
