What should/could be improved?

- More structure
- Focus in technical questions of cases, we spent too much time discussing the easy, qualitative questions would be better to focus on the questions that lead to uncertainties --> In order to really master the topics
- More transparent grading of the cases and feedback (e.g. scores for each questions)
- - the cases are REALLY old --> it would be much more interesting to have more recent cases
- questions on ilias were mostly only answered by repeating the questions
- grading of cases is very intransparent
- work load in no relation to ECTS and grades compared to other classes
  - no clear grading and feedback
  - what is necessary, what was missing?
  - what gives how many points?
  - Grade should depend on the content of the assignment, not on comparisons with other groups work
