

## Diary Study "Workplace Learning Support" (WLS)

Researchers in Business Education at the University of Mannheim (<u>Professor Dr. Andreas Rausch</u>, <u>Professor Dr. Jürgen Seifried</u>) are currently conducting the research project "Workplace Learning Support" (WLS) in cooperation with SAP SE and tts GmbH. The three-stage research project addresses the central questions: How do employees overcome challenges when using standard software in everyday office life, how do they learn during this process, and how can they be supported? A standardized diary study in the workplace is planned as the core of the project. For this, we are **currently looking for companies** that are **interested in participating** and would like to learn more about the use of software and the resulting learning of their employees. The planned start here is **autumn 2021**.

In order to gain a detailed insight into the processes taking place in the workplace a **survey diary** is used. The diary is filled in by employees **several times a day** over several working days. The diary entries take **only a few minutes** and are completed quickly. During the survey phase, participants are asked to keep the diary for **15 working days**. The diary is provided in **digital version**. A sample size of approximately 30 participating employees per cooperating company is desirable. If the number of participants is at least 30, we can offer the participating companies a **company-specific evaluation of the data** of their participating employees.
