




The course contents were very well structured.


The course contents were illustrated very well by using appropriate examples.




Digitalization

I wish there had been more contact with teachers while studying with the online learning environment.



Open Questions

What did you particularly like about this course?

- Online lectures in Youtube -> more flexibility, re-watch topics I did not understand well, re-watching the end of chapter questions really helped me
 - Big thumbs up for using alternating genders throughout the course (the investor ... she/ he). This rarely happens in any university courses.
- I feel like I gained a lot of practical knowledge that I can apply in my envisaged career in the investment industry. Covering valuation approaches together with a description of the actual market situation and applied investment schemes fit well together.
- The Youtube videos and the drawings the professor sometimes makes to better explain a concept
- The course is really well-structured and Prof. Theissen explained all the topics very well! He is also helpful and open to any question we have.
- The course was very well structured and the delivery of content was very easy to understand

What should be improved?

- Could incorporate more real-world current affairs related into the fixed income market.
- For me, sometimes the regressions we discuss are a bit hard to interpret. We had two examples in the end of chapter question. However, I would have liked a small general introduction as to how interpret these regressions (this holds even more for the investments course).
- In general nothing, maybe valuing a random existing bond in class and creating a small portfolio using the cell matching approach in

class could be good additions to the presentations.

Some concepts should be explained a little bit more in general first.
E.g. I could not follow the lecture about securitization, before reading the wikipedia page on what it actually is and only after that I started understanding the lecture.

There are also too many required readings, which don t add anything to the lectures. It says just the same as we saw in the lecture again, but I lost a lot of time reading it all.
