What did you especially like about the course?

- - Hands-on topics

- The format of the actual seminar

What should/could be improved?

- - Large differences in the amount of work required for different topics
  - further statistics courses to be offered as preparation would be helpful
- - precise grading of the presentation/ seminar participation would be good
  - a lot of questions were asked only to say something
  - communication of the amount of pages incl. graphs could be improved
- - add more structure
  - reply to all mails
  - should be worth more credits given the work
- I had the impression that I was left alone. During the seminar most students work empirically for the first time, so it would be good not to leave somebody entirely alone but instead to provide some guidance how to structure an empirical analysis. I know that an own contribution is important but some general advice would be useful. Moreover the supervisor did not really seem interested in my work.
- In total more topics from the finance area.
  - A link between Seminar and Master Thesis.
  - Advanced Econometrics should replace other monodular classes (e.g. CSR, DA) for the MMM.
- More office hours should be offered for methodology and empirical issues.
- My name tag was not printed.
- State more clearly the format of the presentation to be held by students.
- Supervisor gave wrong page number, that was only cleared up a week before the dead line.
  - Provide students with last year's seminar papers to give guidance on expectations.
  - Give clear insights on grading criteria.
