- Link between lectures and exercises could have been better interpreted.

Also, 10 credits is a low amount of credits for the workload we have to do.
- case studies take too much effort; there should be more creits attened for the workload of case studies.
- it should be stated that e.g. Investments is recommened to take before, and not any finance course (as CFI was not helpfull at all in my case, giving me sometimes a hard time)

- stata Tutorials are very intense/ time-consuming, maybe use more step-by-step tasks.
